___ Registration and Recharter Follow-up Parents (Year-round, but most assistance needed October through December for current Scouts and again in February and early March when Webelos Scouts bridge over.) Responsible for speaking face-to-face with parents/guardians at meetings and making timely follow up calls until every Scout's complete registration packet and payment is collected and turned into the Committee Chair for processing.

___ Record Keeping/Bookkeeping (Assist Treasurer, Advancement and Committee Chair with paperwork or electronic records as needed)

___ Recruitment Chairman (_____ – requires some training and excellent public speaking and written communication skills. Interact with local Cub Scout Packs and schools to encourage youth to register with Troop 37 so we can remain a dynamic and well-supported unit in the NWSC. Work with Registration and Recharter Follow-up Parents, Committee Chair and Advancement Chair.)

___ Quartermaster Committee (Assist with the procurement, maintenance, inspection, and repair of Troop equipment and Trailer)
